Re-use cascade training session plan



Theme

Hiring/Leasing/Borrowing

Objectives

To get participants to consider whether they need to buy items or whether they could actually hire, lease or borrow them.

Outcomes

Participants will have the knowledge of how to get an outfit for a special occasion without buying anything new.

You will need

- Pen and paper
- Access to a computer or smart phone for every individual
- Internet/wifi access
- Or a Yellow Pages/phone book



Instructions for the group

It's quite normal for people to rent a kilt for a wedding or big event, but most people rarely rent other clothing or accessories.

Your task is

- 1) To list items all the items you'd need for a big event that you've got coming up such as a wedding or a ball (include shoes, jewellery, accessories etc).
- 2) Against each of those items, identify a supplier where you can get those items, including their contact details and a rough price if you can find it.

Then show the outfit to the rest of the group and tell them the cost and suppliers. Remember you can rent, lease, or borrow.
