




Who does the toolbar help?

Toolbar accessibility features

Screen reader







The screen reader helps visitors to perceive and understand our digital content by reading aloud website text, which can be customised to suit the viewer.

The accessibility toolbar provides five main tools; a ruler, screen mask, magnifier, margins, and a dictionary.

Styling and customisation













The toolbar allows people to change the way our website looks. Users are able to customise the website's colour scheme as well as the text, font style, size, colour, and spacing.
