Here's how to apply the yellow breakfast bar look to a piece of furniture

We've chosen an old writing desk to transform with this technique, but you can apply this process to other types of furniture.

You'll need:

- Chalk paint
- Rollers
- Sandpaper
- Masking tape



What do I need to do?

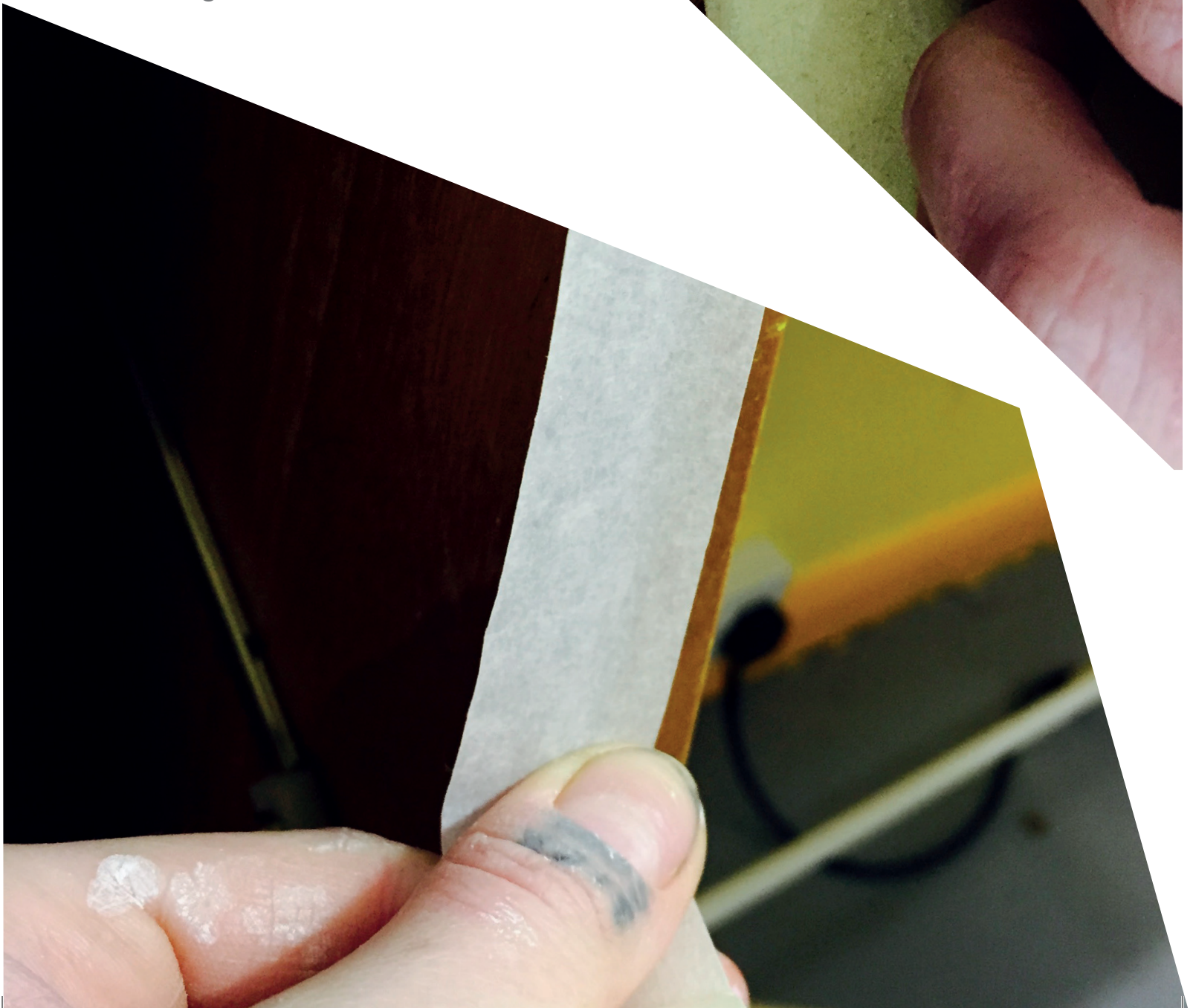
Follow this easy step by step guide:

1 Sand

Key the piece by sanding it all over with the sand paper.

2 Mask

Mask off areas that are remaining wood.



3 Paint

Apply as many coats of paint as needed with roller.

Lightly sand between coats with a fine grit paper.

4 Clean

Remove masking tape and smooth out any edges with a damp cloth.

5 Varnish

Apply two coats of Matt varnish with roller.
